Our classic, understated black box theatre. A great space for cabaret, rehearsals, workshops, meetings and intimate theatre productions.

This adaptable venue had 105 seats in a retractable fixed tier, standard lighting rig and sound system

FEATURES

Stage Dimensions:

Stage Width – 10 metres

Stage depth – 6 metres

There are three wing bays each side and an upstage crossover. The upstage wall is mirrored and usable for rehearsals and performances. A black wool cloth on a movable track covers it. There is a 2nd wool cloth 500mm DS that is French action and can be operated from prompt side.

Theatrical Sound & Lighting Systems

Theatrical sound & lighting systems are pre-installed in Theatre 2, but do not include operators. Operators can be provided at an extra charge.

Seating Configuration

The seating configuration in Theatre 2 is standard theatre style.

Alternative seating configurations i.e. cabaret style can be achieved by breaking down and re setting the standard configuration.

Dressing Room

Prompt side: There is a single dressing room with space for 4-6 persons.

Opposite Prompt: There is a single dressing room with space for 2-3 persons.

There are no shower, toilet or washing facilities in Theatre 2. The nearest toilets are located on the same level approximately 10 metres from the entry doors.

Loading

Load in is via the laneway beside the Lakeside Room.

Load in is through the Lakeside Room foyer into the lift, up to level 2. Theatre 2 has double entry doors.
