



TIMELINE

1928 - ANDY WARHOL IS BORN.

1947 - Eduardo Paolozzi, (UK) creates one of the first recognised Pop Art works, I Was a Rich Man's Plaything. He starts what is known as the 'Independent Group (IG)'.

1949 - Andy Warhol (US) moves to New York and works as a commercial illustrator.

1956 - Richard Hamilton's (UK) Just what is it that makes today's homes so different, so appealing? is displayed at the White Chapel Art Gallery in London. This work signified the start of the Pop Art movement.

1958 - KEITH HARING IS BORN.

1960 - JEAN-MICHEL BASQUIAT IS BORN.

1961 - Roy Lichtenstein (US) exhibited his piece Look Mickey in the National Gallery of Art in Washington DC.

1962 - Andy Warhol (US) has his first solo show at Irving Blum's Ferus Gallery, Hollywood, consisting of 32 paintings of Campbell's Soup cans.

1962 - Symposium of Pop Art is held at the Museum of Modern Art, New York. The term 'Pop Art' is introduced to the community.

1968 - Valerie Solanas shoots Andy Warhol in The Factory. He has many surgeries to recover.

1976-1987 - Warhol's friend, Pat Hackett transcribes their daily conversations which would be published as *The Andy Warhol Diaries* in 1989.

1977 - Basquiat and Al Diaz begin spray painting the tag SAMO with philosophical poems around New York.

1978 - Basquiat begins selling hand painted post cards and T-shirts. Keith Haring moves to New York.

1980-1987 - Warhol produces two television shows, *Andy Warhol's T.V.* and *Andy Warhol's Fifteen Minutes for MTV*.

1980 - Basquiat exhibits for the first time in the Times Square Show.

1980 - Keith Haring produces his first subway drawings in New York.

1981 - BASQUIAT HAS HIS FIRST SOLO EXHIBITION 1981 at the Galleria d'Art Emilio Mazzoli in Modena, Italy at age 20.

1982 - Keith Haring has his first solo exhibition at the Tony Shafrazi Gallery, New York.

1984 - Warhol, Haring & Basquiat connected professionally in this year. Basquiat and Warhol begin collaborative artworks.

1986 - Keith Haring opens the 'Pop Shop' in New York. He paints his famous *Crack is Wack* mural.

1987 - Warhol dies in New York due to complications following a surgery to remove his gallbladder at age 58.

1988 - Jean-Michel Basquiat dies of a drug overdose at age 27.

1990 - Keith Haring dies of AIDS related complications at age 31.
